ABN Membership Categories

Ordinary Membership. ABN Rule 4.1.1 states:

Those appointed to consultant posts, or equivalent, in the neurological sciences, and others who have contributed significantly to the discipline in the United Kingdom and Ireland, shall be eligible for Ordinary Membership.

Associate Membership. ABN Rule 4.1.5 states:

All specialty registrars and others pursuing clinical practice or research in clinical neurology or related disciplines within the United Kingdom and Ireland shall be eligible for Associate Membership.

Affiliate Membership. ABN Rule 4.1.6 states:

General practitioners with a special interest in neurology, Associate Specialists/Staff Grades in Neurology, and junior hospital doctors who are not neurology specialist trainees within the United Kingdom and Ireland shall be eligible for Affiliate membership.

Overseas Membership. ABN Rule 4.1.4 states:

Ordinary Members who cease to reside in the United Kingdom and Ireland shall be deemed Overseas Members. In addition persons of British or Irish nationality who have left the United Kingdom and Ireland to work abroad, others with significant past or present association with British neurology, or others who have made significant contributions to neurology internationally, shall be eligible for election to Overseas Membership.

Please note:

- Applications for Overseas Membership must include a letter of recommendation from a full (Consultant) Member of the Association.
- Annual membership is from June to June and fees are as detailed in the table below.
- Members joining part way through the year
 - will receive membership benefits relating to their membership category with immediate effect however formal confirmation of membership will occur at the next AGM.
 - will receive an invoice for the appropriate portion of their first membership year, as indicated in table below,
